PROMISING DRUG TRIAL

We are excited to announce our support of a new clinical trial for ALKdriven neuroblastoma. Lorlatinib, an investigational drug candidate currently in late stage clinical development for the treatment of lung cancer, may also prove effective in treating neuroblastoma. In a collaborative effort among several like-minded nonprofits, we helped to fund this International Phase 1 clinical trial that will be available across 14 US hospitals in the NANT consortium, as well as two European sites in the UK and France.

Other Trial Highlights

Combination of Cell-Mediated and Antibody-Mediated Immunotherapy for High-Risk Neuroblastoma: Phase I Study of Haploidentical Natural Killer Cells plus Humanized 3F8: As of February, 2017, 29 subjects (10 patients and 19 donors) have been registered for assessment and undergone HLA and KIR genotyping. Two patients had received two cycles each of haploidentical cells plus hu3F8. Approximately 6-10 patients are expected to be enrolled by the end of August, 2017. (MSKCC, Dr. Shakeel Modak)

Bivalent Vaccine Plus Beta-Glucan for High-Risk Neuroblastoma in First Remissionentails giving the NB vaccine frontline, in children who have not relapsed. Our goal is to prevent relapse of high-risk neuroblastoma patients in first remission after completion of standard of care, using the bivalent vaccine plus beta-glucan. This could prove to be a groundbreaking trial with the potential to change the treatment of neuroblastoma. The results have been outstanding for the relapsed children -- imagine the same impact for first line therapy. (MSKCC, Dr. Brian Kushner)
